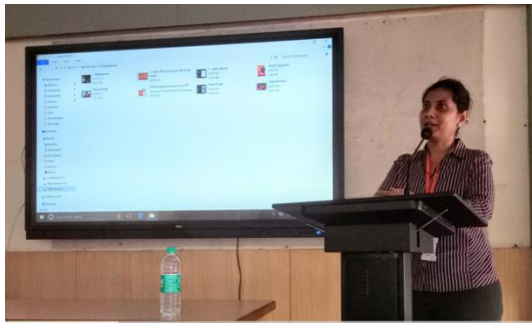
1. Masquerade party
