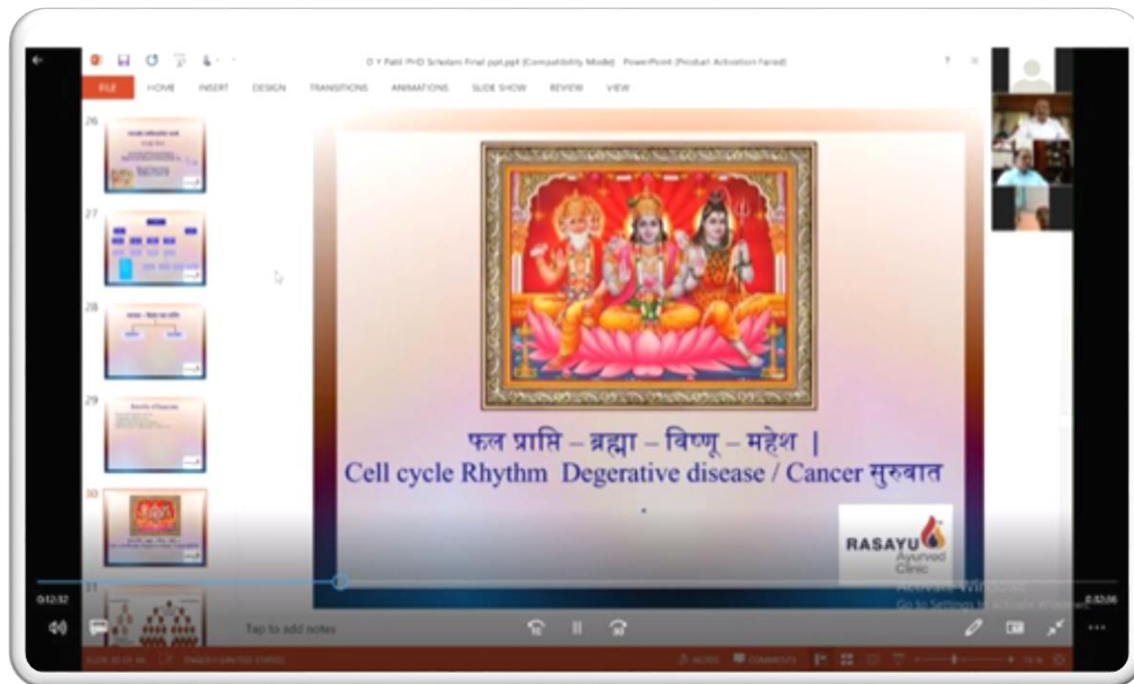

Institutional Ethics Committee 2020 for PG students



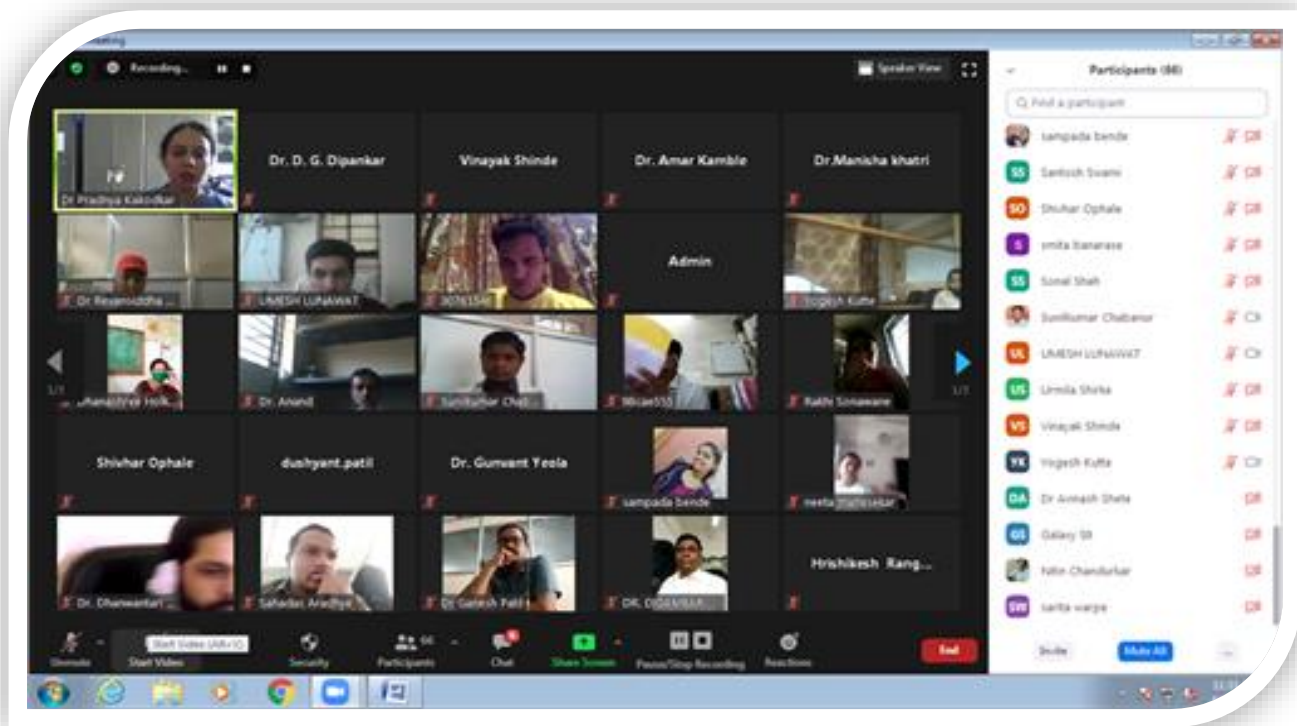

Dr. Gunvant Yeola gave motivation to the Ph. D. Scholars for doing good Research work & Publications.

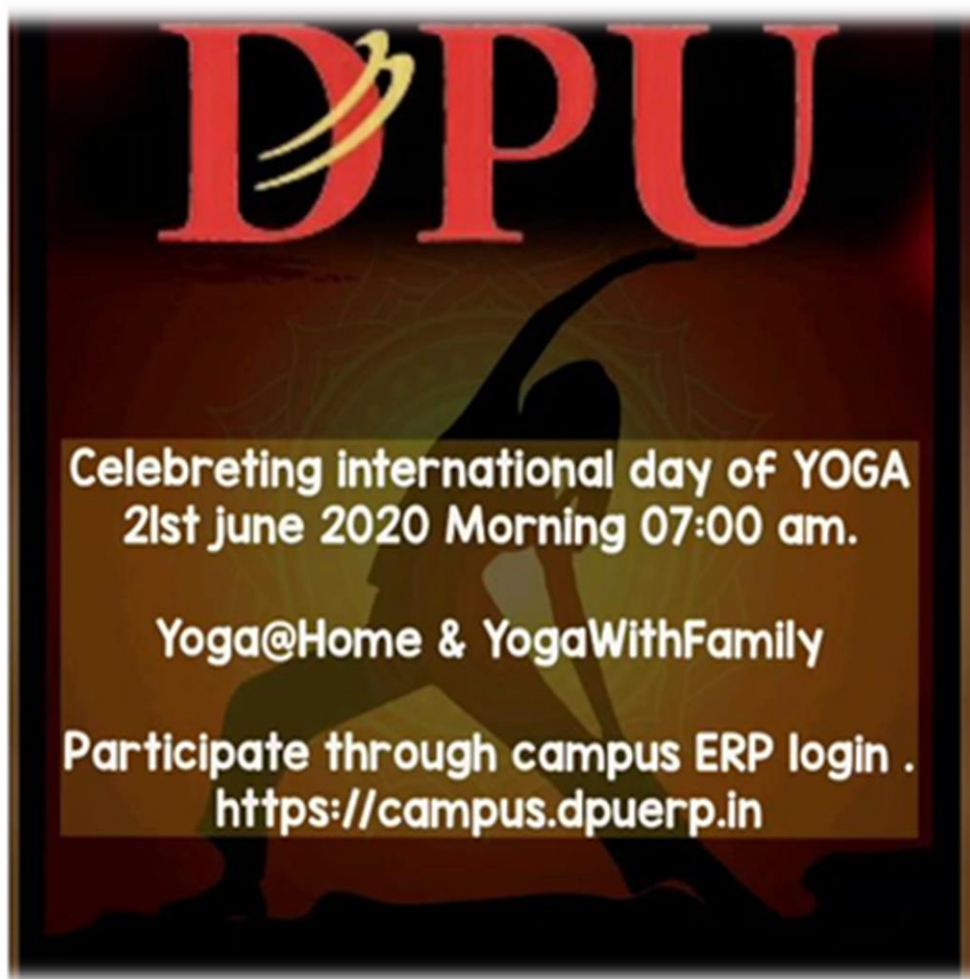

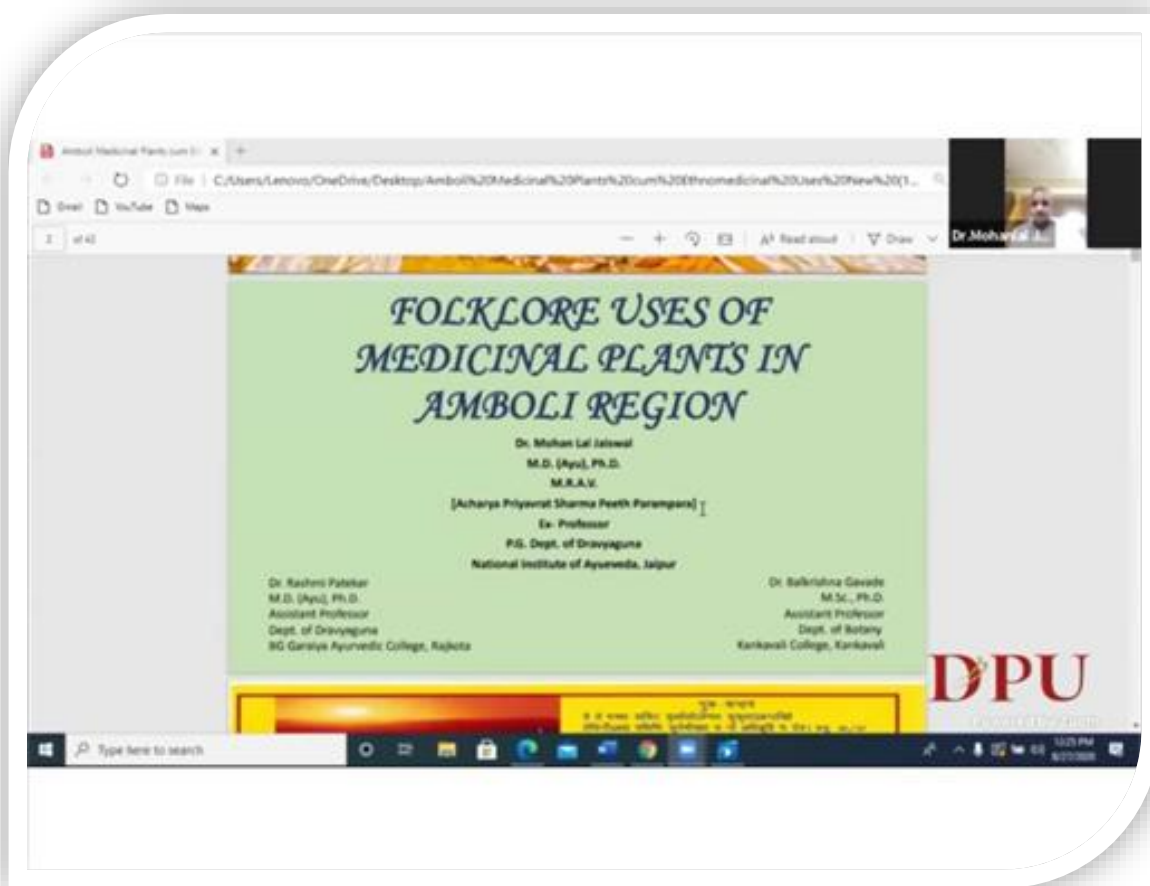
The best part of the workshop was Group Activities in which the participant involved in group activity with their different ideas and knowledge.
