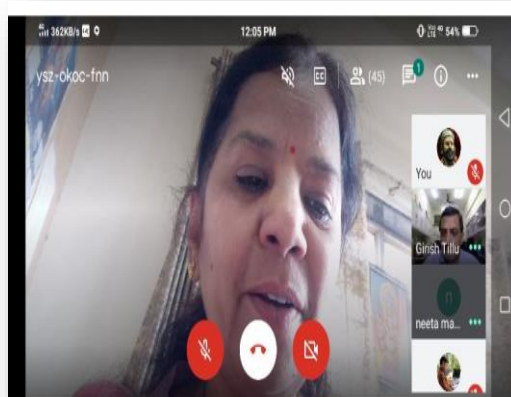
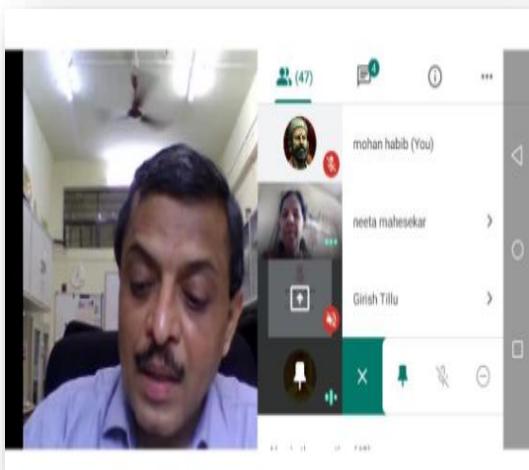
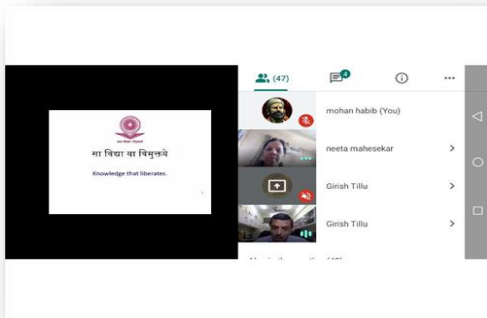

## Guest Lecturer on “Insights into a Systematic Approach in undertaking Ayurvedic Research Projects

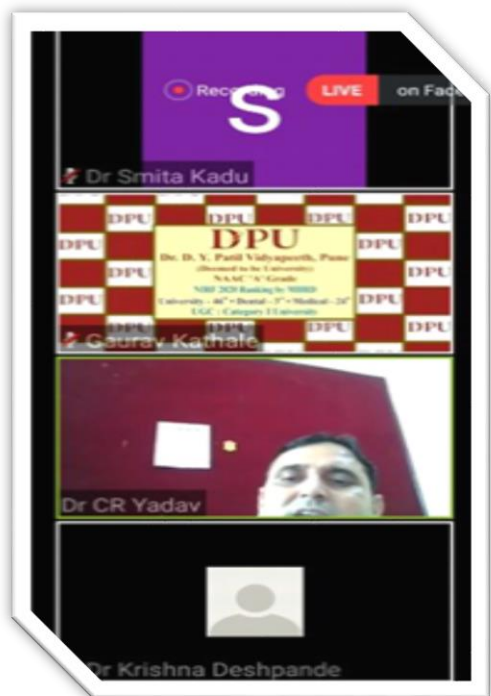

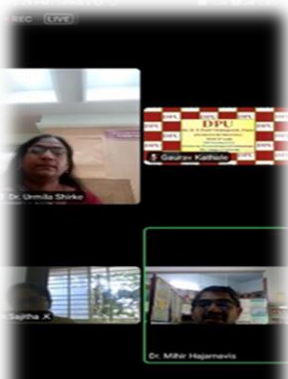

## Opening Ceremony of Paralysis Ayurved Treatment Centre

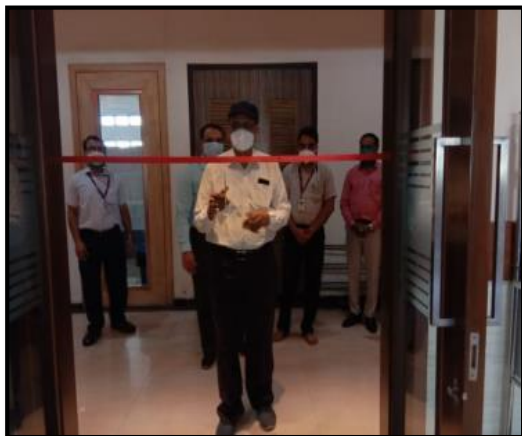

Elocution competition was conducted online on 12th November at 10.30 Am to 12 Pm. 8 participants participated and two were selected as winners, they are-

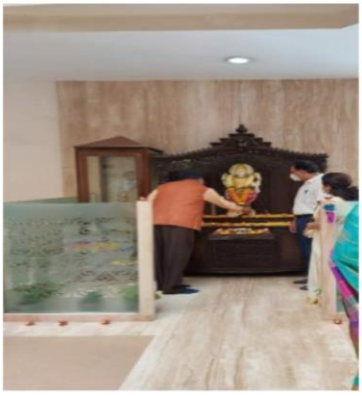

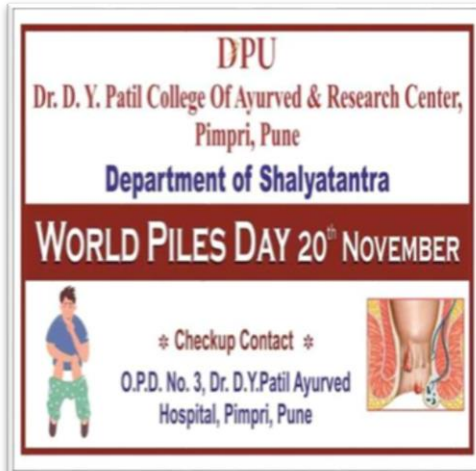

# World Piles Day Celebration 2020

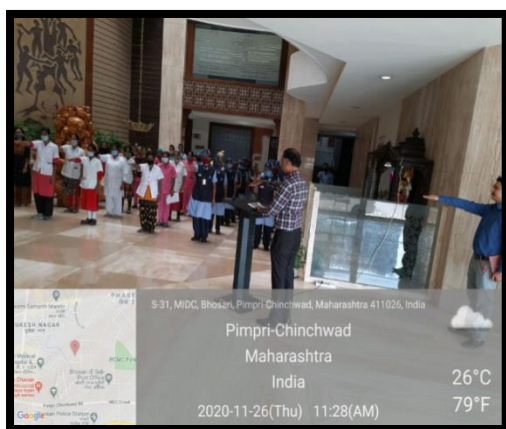
